

Meeting of the City of Bloomsdale
January 9, 2024

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM with the following in attendance: Mayor Paul Monia, City Clerk Lynnette Randall, Aldermen Monica Rozier and Chris Basler. Aldermen John Schweigert and Brandon Shortt were absent.

The Meeting opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

The minutes from the December Meeting were read and approved with a motion from Alderman Chris Basler, seconded by Monica Rozier.

Alderman Monica Rozier made a motion to pay all current expenditures, seconded by Chris Basler. The motion was unanimously approved.

Overdue water bills were reviewed. Notices were sent Wednesday, 01/03/2024.

Mayor Monia reported that he scheduled Loida Farms to lime the field at the Treatment Plant where sludge is land applied twice per year. This is required by DNR. The new meter to be installed at Love's has been received by Vern Bauman Contracting. They will install at their earliest opportunity. CE Contracting is waiting on parts to replace the Hydrant at the Treatment Plant. It will be completed as soon as possible. They are also scheduled to rock the road leading to the Plant.

Clerk's Notes: On December 14th, Wayne Basler requested that the City pay for a lighted flagpole for the Knights of Columbus property. The price is \$39.99 plus tax, free delivery. The Council approved the purchase and Clerk Randall will pay the company directly when delivered. Lightwave Communications submitted a quote for internet service at the Treatment Plant. The Mayor would like to table this subject for 6 months. The annual Boundary report for the Census Bureau was submitted 1-3-2024. Clerk Randall has had trouble collecting the Real Estate and Personal Property Tax bills for the Love's Travel Stops. The Real Estate bill was returned twice, unable to deliver and once stating that Ryan Tax, LLC no longer manages that account. The Personal Property Tax received no response. Randall is working on contacting someone and will collect the money! Clerk Randall's SAM Renewal is due by February 23, 2024. If she is unable to accomplish this alone, Mike Wittu will assist. Missouri DNR has also added a new requirement for submitting the Annual Water Usage Data Report. An account must be set up.

Alderman Chris Basler made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 7:30 PM, seconded by Monica Rozier. The motion was approved.
