

Meeting of the City of Bloomsdale
March 12, 2024

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM with the following in attendance: Mayor Paul Monia, City Clerk Lynnette Randoll, Aldermen Chris Basler, John Schweigert, Brandon Shortt and Monica Rozier.

The Meeting opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

The minutes from the February Meeting were read and approved with a motion from Alderman Monica Rozier, seconded by John Schweigert.

Alderman Chris Basler made a motion to pay all current expenditures, seconded by John Schweigert. The motion was unanimously approved.


Overdue water bills were reviewed. Notices were sent Wednesday, 03/06/2024.

TJ with Cochran was not required to attend the Meeting. Mayor Monia reported that he spoke with the Everetts at 620 Highway 61 regarding the Easement on their property on Clement Road. The City has agreed to remove three trees and one stump to lower the 20' Easement to a 10' Construction, 5' Utility Easement. Alderman Shortt reported some complaints about the soccer field at the K of C Hall being rutted up. They thought it was from the City land applying sludge, but the Mayor assured that does not happen. It was from someone else. Alderman Schweigert has noticed the Park being open late at night. Clerk Randoll will follow up.

Clerk's Notes: The Major Water Use Report was completed and submitted to DNR on Thursday, February 15th. The Cincinnati Insurance Company has notified the City before renewal in June as required by state law some exclusions on the new policy: a War Exclusion endorsement; a Nuclear, Biological, Chemical and Radiological Hazards Exclusion on the Commercial Inland Marine Coverage; and a Nuclear, Biological, Chemical and Radiological Hazards Exclusion on the Commercial Property Coverage. Clerk Randoll contacted Ramona with the Missouri Municipal League on 2/15/24 regarding the political sign at 82 Mill Hill Road. She sent several articles about similar situations. The bottom line seems to be that if a Government Entity tries to put restrictions on displays on private property, it opens up the possibility of lawsuits. Clerk Randoll received communication that the Ste. Genevieve Commissioners are trying to break the contract with Mid-America Rehab for the satellite Community Center at 490 Highway 61.

Alderman Chris Basler made a motion to enter a closed session at 7:25 PM, seconded by Brandon Shortt for Personnel purposes.
